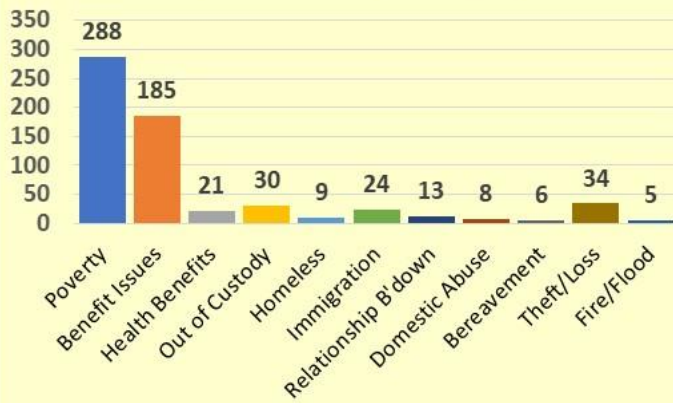

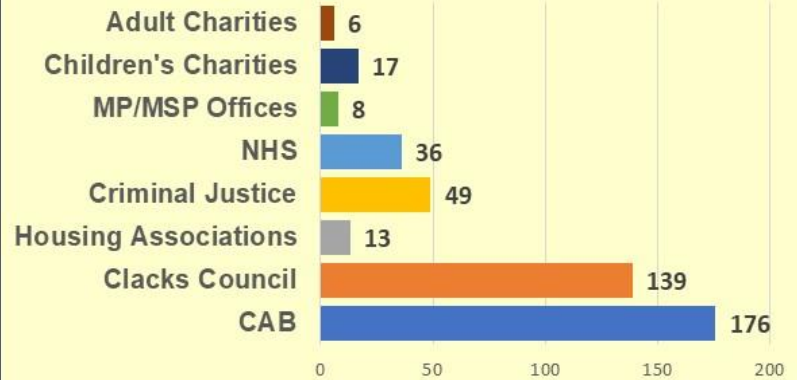
Stock Urgently Needed! Please Help!

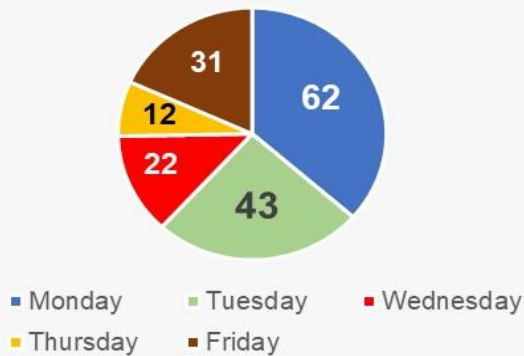

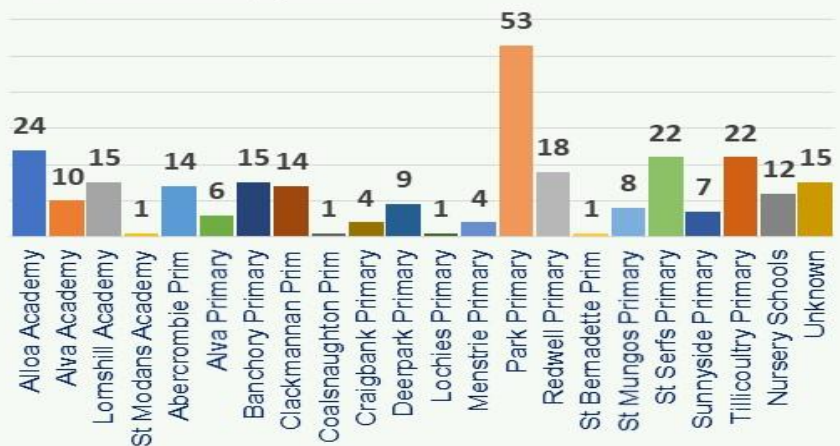

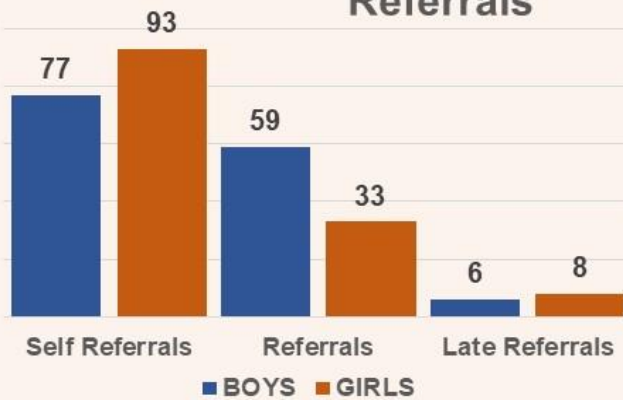
OPEN WEEK: No of Children Supported Each Day



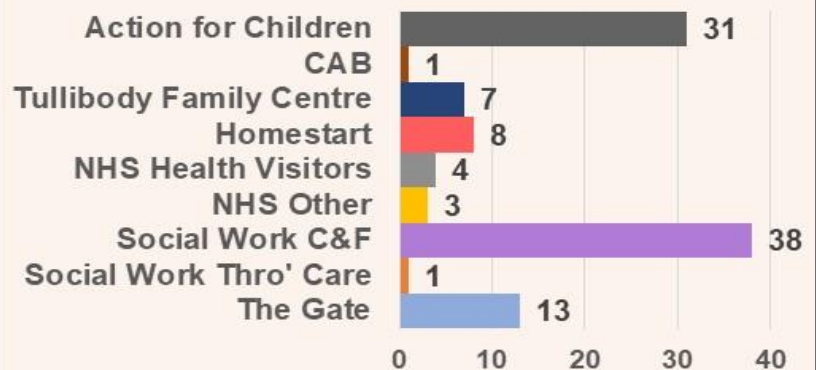

SOUP POT PROJECT UPDATE:

Approximately **335** people visited our Soup Pot during Quarter 2 to access FREE food, drinks, recycled clothing, toiletry packs and social involvement.

HOME STARTER PACK PROJECT UPDATE:

During Quarter 2, we distributed **8 packs**, supporting **8 adults, 3 children and 1 baby**. Packs are tailored to individual needs and distributed via a referral system in partnership with housing departments. The aim of this project is to support people who are moving from homeless accommodation into a new tenancy.
